## Our History

Omaha 100 was incorporated in 1990 by Holy Name Housing Corporation in conjunction with John Maloney, former Vice President of Bank of the West (formerly known as Commercial Federal Bank).

With the support of the founders, the board of directors, and the direct program staff, Omaha 100 developed into a successful mortgage lending program.



## How Omaha 100 Works

Omaha 100 provides conventional mortgage financing to approved applicants purchasing homes from community development corporations, public housing authorities, and from private homeowners on the open market. Omaha 100 also offers a Nebraska Investment Finance Authority (NIFA) mortgage loan to applicants purchasing a home from a private homeowner on the open market.

Omaha 100 assists applicants who otherwise would not qualify for assistance from traditional bank financing due to credit issues and/or insufficient savings for down payment and closing cost.

Omaha 100's general target area is the census tracts East of 72nd Street to the Missouri River, North to Interstate 680 and South to Harrison Street.
